Biosecurity Protocol

ATTENTION ATTENTION ATTENTION

All horses must be checked in by Dr. Laureen Bartfield, DVM CVSMT.

All horse's temperatures must be checked by the owner

before the horse comes off the trailer.

You may unload in the tree grove, but must move your trailers **immediately** following unloading.

All Manure must be picked out of both indoor and outdoor arenas. Please return to do pick up after stalling your horse.

ALL trailers must park in the North Field, not in the tree grove or lower area

All horses must follow USET Biosecurity Protocol as follows:

All horses must follow USET Biosecurity Protocol (we are following USEF Rule GR845).

All horses entering the USET Foundation grounds must be accompanied by the following:

- 1) Documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. THIS IS MANDATORY FOR EVERY HORSE ENTRY AND THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS! Horses not in compliance with this will be required to leave the grounds upon request of the USET Foundation.
- 2) **Statement of Health**, signed by a licensed veterinarian within 7 days of arrival at USET Foundation property.
- 3) **Current negative EIA** (Coggins) Test.
- 4) Current vaccinations against WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus and Rabies are strongly recommended.
- 5) It is required that all riders document in writing their horses temperatures for **72 hours PRIOR to arrival** at the USET Foundation Stable. Please do **NOT** ship horses with elevated temperatures.

It is required that <u>written temperature logs</u> be kept on a daily basis (2x's per day) for all horses stabled at the USET Foundation for the duration of their stay. (Yes, really. If USET asks you must produce or leave!!)

Any horse on the grounds with a fever of unknown origin must be reported immediately

Horses not in compliance will be required to vacate the grounds immediately.

If an elevated temperature is found please notify a veterinarian and the USET Foundation immediately.
